

CUSTOMER-PROVIDED WIRE REQUIREMENTS AT WEATHERHEAD:

100A SERVICE: #4-STRANDED COPPER WITH #8 GROUND

125A SERVICE: #2-STRANDED COPPER WITH #8 GROUND


200A SERVICE: #2/0 COPPER WITH #4 GROUND

*NEUTRAL WIRE MUST BE MARKED WHITE AT BOTH WEATHERHEAD & PANEL

HOW TO ACQUIRE TEMPORARY ELECTRIC SERVICE:

- 1) Submit a New Service Questionnaire with C.O.B. Electric Utility at 176 E. Lincoln St. and request initial inspection for temporary electric service pole/panel location. A panel submittal review may be requested by utility inspector.
- 2) Contact C.O.B. Building & Safety Department at (951)922-3132 to acquire a temporary electric service permit. The Building & Safety Department is located inside City Hall at 99 E. Ramsey St.
- 3) Coordinate all future inspections with C.O.B. Building & Safety Department. C.O.B. Electric Utility will inspect the installation following Building & Safety's approval.
- 4) Contact C.O.B. Utility Billing at (951)922-3185 to establish a temporary electric service account after the installation has been approved. The Utility Billing Department is located inside City Hall at 99 E. Ramsey St.

NOTE: Temporary electric service cannot exceed 18 months without prior written approval. Temporary electric service is only allowed with an active construction permit for the requesting address.
