Description of Classifications

A General Engineering Contractor

A general engineering contractor is a contractor whose principal contracting business is in connection with fixed works requiring specialized engineering knowledge and skill, including water power, water supply, flood control, inland waterways, harbors, docks and wharves, shipyards and ports, dams and hydroelectric projects, levees, river control and reclamation works, railroads, highways, streets and roads, tunnels, airports and airways, sewers and sewage disposal plants and systems, waste reduction plants, bridges, overpasses, underpasses, pipelines, power plants, refineries, utilities plants, land leveling and earthmoving projects, excavating, grading, trenching, paving and surface work, concrete works in connection with the above mentioned work.

B General Building Contractor

A general building contractor is a contractor whose principal contracting business is in connection with any structure built, for the support, shelter and enclosure of persons, animals, chattels or moveable property of any kind requiring in its construction the use of at least two unrelated building trades or crafts, or to do or superintend the whole or any part thereof.

C-2 Insulation and Acoustical Contractor

An insulation and acoustical contractor installs any insulating media and performed architectural materials for the purpose of temperature and/or sound control.

C-4 Boiler, Hot Water Heating and Steam Fitting Contractor

A boiler, hot water heating and steam fitting contractor installs, services and repairs power boiler installations, hot water heating systems and steam fittings.
